DESCRIPTION

We have explored the basic concepts of making images with balanced exposure. We have also discussed ways to use exposure, depth of field (DOF), and motion blur creatively. Take some time with your camera to explore these settings and techniques. Work to create the following images for submission:

- Exposure - 3 images :: under-exposed, over-exposed and balanced/even exposure.
- Shutter Speed - 2 images :: motion blur and frozen motion
- Aperture - 3 images :: wide, moderate, and shallow DOF
- ISO - 2 images :: balanced exposure with minimal noise (low ISO), image with pronounced noise distortion (high ISO)

Keep a notepad and pen/pencil with you and record your settings for the images as you take them, making note of the changes you decide to make. This will help you to begin seeing how setting changes affect your final image.

There is no need for any cropping or retouching for this assignment.

GRADING CRITERIA

Each image receives 1/2 point for submission, and 1/2 point for adequately representing its concept. Files are due at the beginning of class session on the date specified above. They will be considered late if not received by 10:00pm on that date, and a 0 will be granted.
